

River Chew Map Activity Answers

1. Chew Valley Lake is the large blue water body
2. The 5th grid square from the right side of the map.
3. 5: Chew Magna, Stanton Drew, Pensford, Woollard, Compton Dando
4. There are 7 road bridges visible on the map
5. Any of the smaller streams which join the Chew. Source: where it starts.
6. Subjective – a particularly bendy part about 1 grid square in size.
7. About 15 km plus or minus 3 km.
8. A place where the contour lines are close together and is not woodland (green).
9. The straight part at the northern edge of the reservoir with a road over it.
10. Anywhere with green patches (woodland) next to the river. White is farmland.
